Seniors are often scammed through automated robocalls, but there are some good tools to reduce robocalls.

Samsung's SmartCall informs you if the call you are receiving is from a known robocaller. This feature is available with Samsung Galaxy phones.

Google also has a spam blocker for Android phones that will warn you when you are receiving a robocall and your screen will turn red.

AT&T also offers free apps to block robocalls on iPhones and Android phones.

Verizon's CallerName ID is a free service for iPhones and Android phones that will alert you to suspected robocallers.

T-Mobile offers a free scam blocker of known robocallers for Android phones which you can activate by merely dialing #662#

Sprint offers a paid service to protect your iPhone or Android phone from robocalls.
